



To 4580 Chemin de Lac Gagnon Ouest, Duhamel QC 46° 07' N 75° 08' 20"W



At the intersection of King Edward and Rideau,
set trip meter to zero.
Head North to get on the #50.



Take the 50 Est (East)



Get off the 50 at Rue George.
Head South.



When you get to the 148 head Est (East)(Left)



Coming into Mason, stay to the right (Lachute on sign).
Head towards Thurso (stinky-town).
Mason is where the Cumberland ferry will get you to.

To 4580 Chemin de Lac Gagnon Ouest, Duhamel QC - Continued



OD - plus 50.7 kms (reset)
At the lights in Thurso, turn left (317 Nord [North])



OD - plus 28.1 kms (reset)
At the "T" coming into Ripon, turn right (317 North)
Go straight thru Ripon (watch the hill down)



OD - plus 7.1 kms (reset)
At the "T" head North (left) 321Nord, 317 Nord

Watch it, it's 4 lanes (get in the right hand lane asap, so the crazy bastages can get around you going up the hill.)



Coming into Cheneville. This is the last Metro (food store) on the way. Keep going straight.



OD - plus 7.5 kms (reset)
At the Stop sign in Cheneville. Go straight.

*Note: the back of the white house as you start to turn round the right hand corner is the Butcher. Very good meat incl. venison (in season).

To 4580 Chemin de Lac Gagnon Ouest, Duhamel QC - Continued



OD - plus 19.4 kms (reset)
At the Stop sign in Duhamel, turn right.

The store on the left is the last place to get beer and smokes etc. before the cottage.



OD - plus 12.9 kms (do not reset)
You are VERY close when you can see the telephone and mail boxes on the right.



OD - plus 13 kms
You are at the end of the driveway to Kempster's Sanctuary.

Turn right, go slow.



If at night, stop at the top of the hill and go down with a flashlight to make sure the road is still passable.
After the top of the hill, stay close to the left. The shoulder on the right is not stable. There may be wash-out from the rain.
There is a "U" turn to get onto my property, that if you don't make it, you might get stuck.



Stay to the left and carve hard to get onto the upper level. Do not drive or park on the area marked by the orange markers. It is the weeping bed.

Park on this level near the fire-pit and walk down the last hill to the cottage as the rain has possibly made it impassible (even with 4-wheel drive).

Unlock the door using the lock under the door handle
(turn counter-clockwise to unlock)

You have made it!

Go downstairs (watch your head). The electrical panel is on the left (West wall).
Turn on all the breakers, but not the water heater and baseboard heaters.
Go down to the lower basement level (watch your head).
Open the valve at the bottom of the blue water tank
(turn counter-clockwise until fully open. you should hear water flow for a moment).
Plug the water pump into the 220v socket in the ceiling. It may start.
If it starts, wait to make sure it shuts off (30 - 45 seconds.)
Go into the kitchen and run the water to remove any air in the lines.
Go back down to the elec. panel and turn on the hot water heater. (watch your head)
You're done. Have fun!

***** VERY IMPORTANT *****

**This waste system uses a pump to push the effluent up to the weeping system.
Any liquids (or semi-solids) that come out of your body and a small amount of toilet
paper, are THE ONLY THINGS that are to be flushed down the toilet!!!
(Small bits of food and soapy water can go down the other drains.) (Watch out for bread
bag clips - they could be pump killers.)**

**IF ANYTHING ELSE GOES DOWN THE DRAINS, TURN THE BREAKER OFF FOR THE
PUMPS IMMEDIATELY!! - THEN CALL ME. (the offending material must be removed from
the poop tank in the basement - the pump costs \$1500.00 to replace, and it's not a job
I want to do AGAIN.)**
